THE BOOK OF JOEL

- Prophet to Southern Kingdom
- Preached after the land was destroyed by locusts and drought
- This devastation was nothing compared to what was coming
- Turn to God, ask for forgiveness while there was still time

JOEL 2:28-32

- Pay attention to the list:
 - Sons AND Daughters
 - Old men
 - Young men
 - Servants

PENTECOST

- Required a journey
- “Pentecost” means 50th (Leviticus 23:16)
- Also called “Feast of Weeks”
- Was a countdown – theme of godly anticipation



1 CORINTHIANS 11:26

“For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.”



PENTECOST

- Also known as Festival of First Fruits
- First Fruits is dedicating our first and best to the glory of God

GRATITUDE TO GOD

- Gratitude creates a desire to give back
- God is the ultimate giver
- God does not abandon His people
- Following God is not always accompanied by feelings of security
- Anxiety isn't necessarily the opposite of faith

THE HOLY SPIRIT

- Was poured out upon them (fell on them)
- Filled them (for the purpose of glorifying God)
- Flowed from them to touch others
